

## Transparency Statement

Vysiion is committed to ensuring our business and supply chains are free of slavery.

Vysiion acknowledges responsibility to comply with all principles of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will perform due diligence to provide transparency throughout the organization, through policies and procedures (e.g. POL010, POL046).

To satisfy the requirement we ask our suppliers to provide evidence of their compliance to the Act.

Vysiion's Senior Management will take responsibility of implementing this policy and its objectives and will provide the necessary resources to ensure that its practices are effective in ensuring that modern day slavery is not taking place.
